**Step 1**: Clear your Firearm - Check the chamber, bolt face and magazine well.



**Step 2**: Fold your Sub 2000 in half. Press down on the hard plastic recoil buffer. Then pull out that buttstock pin.



Step 3: Remove the hard plastic buffer and the buttstock

**Step 4**: Pull up on the charging handle and you will be able to change it out with M\*CARBO Recoil Buffer.





**Step 5**: Slide the Recoil Buffer over top of the recoil spring inside of the receiver tube. Pull the charging handle to bring it down.



**Step 6**: Put the buttstock back on, Place the hard plastic buffer at the end. Line up the holes to put the buttstock pin back in place.

Step 7: Finally, Check the operation of the Sub 2000
