
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
Step 1: Clear your Firearm - Check the Chamber, Bolt Face and Magazine Well.



- MCARBO Ruger PC Carbine 303 Stainless Steel Trigger Group Pin Kit
- 2. 5/32" Allen Key or T-Handle
- 3. 1/16" 3/32" and 1/8" Punches
- Hammer
- 5. Bench Block
- Eye Protection

Step 2: Gather Parts and Tools needed for Installation.





Step 3: Pull Forward on the Release on the Underside of the Barrel.

Rotate the Barrel 45 Degrees and Remove it.



Step 4: Open your MCARBO Ruger PC Carbine 303 Stainless Steel
Trigger Group Pin Kit

Step 5: Use your 5/32" Allen Key to Remove the Front Takedown Screw.







Step 6: Flip it over and Remove the Rear Takedown Screw, Then Take off the Grip.





Step 7: Tap the Trigger Guard with your Palm a few times to Remove it from the Chassis.



Step 8: Make sure your Bolt is Forward, Then use your 1/8" Punch to Push Out the Two Takedown Pins Near the Trigger Group.





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Step 9: Remove the Trigger Assembly.



Step 10: Place the Assembly on Fire and Let your Hammer Forward.



Step 11: Insert the First Small Pin in the Hole near the Bolt Stop. Make sure it is even with the Raised Portion of the Trigger Group.






Step 12: Use your Stainless Steel Pin to Push Out the Factory Hammer Hinge Pin.



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Step 13: Do the Same Thing with the Remaining Pin.





Step 14: Lock back your hammer before Re-Assembling.





Step 15: Turn the Receiver Upright. Make sure the Bolt is Forward and Drop in the Trigger Group.




Step 16: Line up the Trigger Group with the Holes on the Receiver.

Push in the Two Takedown Pins.





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


Step 17: Lay the Chassis Overtop and Press it Back Together.



Step 18: Drop in your Front Takedown Screw and Tighten it with your 5/32" Allen Key.





Step 19: Get your Grip back in Position and Compress it in Place.






Step 20: Keeping the Grip in Place, Drop in the Long Rear Takedown Pin through the Top and Tighten it with your 5/32" Allen Key.





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Step 21: To Re-Insert the Barrel, Push it in to get Started, Then turn the Barrel 45 Degrees towards you, Then Rotate it back into Place.





Step 22: Perform a Function Check. Check your Safety and Trigger Reset.
