#### Step 1

Clear your firearm. Check the Chamber, Bolt Face, and Magazine Well.

### Step 2

Make sure you have all the tools needed:

- 1. 1/16 Allen Wrench
- 2. 5/64 Allen Wrench
- 3. Ruger PC Carbine Extended Magazine Release Kit
- 4. OPTIONAL: Rocksett OR Loctite Blue 242





### Step 3

- Remove the Magazine.
- Take the 1/16 Allen Wrench to loosen the screw holding the factory Magazine Release.
- Remove the screw and factory magazine release.



#### Step 4

Take the new 8/32x1/2" flat head screw, and if using Rocksett or Blue Loctite 242, appy a small dab to the screw before placing in the new Aluminum Extended Mag Release



#### Step 5

Align the screw to thread the spring, and compress the spring, while using the 5/64 Allen Wrench to tighten it up.
